

Dancewear and Shoe Information

BALLET

Female Students

- PINK leather ballet shoes with elastics sewn on
- leotard
- pink tights (preschool dancers can wear socks for class)
- hair in a bun
- no loose jewelry

Male Students

- Black leather ballet shoes with elastics sewn on
- white tank top
- black bike shorts/black or body conscious pants



TAP

- body conscious clothing that allows for movement
- Hair pulled up off face and neck
- no loose jewelry

Younger Students (photo on LEFT)

- black patent leather tap shoes

Older or Int/Adv Students(photo on RIGHT)

- black oxford style tap shoes



JAZZ

- Caramel (tan) leather jazz shoes (may be either lace up or pull on style)
- leotard or bike-a-tard
- tights, bike shorts or leggings
- hair pulled up off face and neck
- No loose jewelry



HIP HOP

For class....

- sneakers/tennis shoes that have not been worn on the street or outside
- clothing that you can move in...jogging pants, sweat shirts, etc.
NO jeans, shorts or skirts

For recital....

teacher will inform you about what style/color shoes you will need to purchase to match your costume

LYRICAL, IMPROV & CONTEMPORARY

- each teacher will have a different preference of shoe style or may even prefer barefoot. Check with your instructor before purchasing shoes
- leotard, tights/leggings/bike shorts
- hair pulled up off face and neck

CLOGGING

- ‘Stevens Stompers’ clogging shoes in white
- clothing that allows for movement
- hair pulled up off face and neck

POINTE

Please see instructor before purchasing pointe shoes and padding and have instructor check your shoes prior to sewing on ribbons or elastics

- dress code is the same as for ballet...leotard, tights, hair in a bun



ACROBATICS

- leotard or bike-a-tard
- bike shorts or legging may be worn
- NO socks or footed tights
- hair pulled up in pony tail or messy bun

LITURGICAL

- leotard or tank top with leggings or bike shorts
- barefoot (no shoes)
- no socks or footed tights
- No jeans, dresses, skirts or jewelry

BATON

Please see instructor before purchasing a baton

- wear form fitting clothing...leotard or tank top with shorts, bike shorts or leggings
- ked style tennis shoes (that have not been worn outside) or jazz shoes
- hair pulled up off face and neck (bun preferred)
- no loose t-shirts, jeans, dresses, skirts or jewelry
